Daniel 3:2-3 And King Nebuchadnezzar sent *word* to gather...all the officials of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which King Nebuchadnezzar had set up. ³ So...all the officials of the provinces gathered together for the dedication of the image that King Nebuchadnezzar had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.
