Job the Great

3. How does Job's attitude help you better understand the importance of parents who are concerned for the spiritual atmosphere of the home?

What is Biblical Perfection?

4. Was Satan invited to this council with God? Explain.

5. How does God's description of Job help your understanding of biblical perfection?

7. What does Job's response to the loss of all his children and possession teach you about how to react to adversity in your own life?
